

Visiting us? We're here to answer some of your Covid-19 FAQs...

Theatre Peckham has reopened – yay!

But the Government have announced new guidelines – oh!

So you're probably feeling a bit confused – yep.

Don't worry, in light of further Government advice to help reduce the spread of Coronavirus, we've tried to answer some key questions about coming to Theatre Peckham to ensure your visit to our home is a safe and enjoyable one.

When can I gather in groups of more than 6?

If you live in a household with more than 6 people, you can continue to gather in and attend all settings together. This same applies for your support bubble.

So, it's absolutely fine to attend your TP Academy class, performance or event and we continue to put our stringent measures in place to ensure your safety, this includes social distancing guides, hand sanitiser stations and room spray downs.

This also applies to our TP Staff, and we are allowed to have more than 6 in the building providing they are not high-fiving, playing Twister or creating a human tower.

Does this mean that no more than six people can come to Theatre Peckham?

Following our Covid-19 secure measures, we are able to host more than 6 people, but no one should visit in a group of greater than 6 (unless you are all from the same household or support bubble).

We know if you see someone you know you'll want to do your special handshake, but we're afraid it will just have to be a knowing nod from a distance.

We'll need to take your details at the door for the NHS Track and Trace programme and your temperature will be taken.

Please wear your mask at all times, unless you're eating and drinking. Eating a crisp through your mask is really hard.



So, it's okay to watch a show/event at Theatre Peckham, even in the theatre?

Absolutely, in fact, we encourage it. But remember, no more than 6 in a group yeah?

Similar to Ghostbusters, we have a fancy spray called Crebisol which is certified to kill bacteria and the coronavirus. It leaves a protective film on our surfaces so don't worry if this is visible in some places.

What about the 10pm rule?

We can stay open after 10pm, providing the show/event started before 10pm. No food or drink will be served after 10pm.

Is your café open?

Yes, and we have some delicious treats and snacks and you'll be delighted to know there's beer and wine too!! However, you'll **only** be able to access these when a performance/event is on and you must use our app to order to reduce queuing at our bar.
