



## UNIFORM GUIDELINES

All Theatre Peckham Academy students are required to wear uniform for their classes, rehearsals, open days, or other performances/events. This is to ensure that they are always wearing appropriate clothing for the activities they are doing, and to ensure that they are comfortable and safe. We advise that members do not wear jewellery for safety reasons.

### **Theatre Peckham's Academy uniform code:**

#### **Acting, musical theatre, singing classes:**

1. All students are required to wear their Theatre Peckham t-shirt (uniform) to all sessions. When this does not happen, Theatre Peckham reserve the right to refuse entry to the session.
2. Black tracksuit bottoms or leggings/trousers you can move freely in, and trainers.

#### **Ballet classes:**

1. Children must wear a red leotard with black tights/leggings, or the Theatre Peckham t-shirt (uniform) with black shorts/leggings/tights.
2. A red skirt or red cardigan and/or leg warmers are optional.
3. Children with long hair must have it tied back.
4. All ballet members must wear ballet shoes.

#### **Tap classes:**

1. All Tap students must wear the Theatre Peckham t-shirt (uniform) and tap shoes.
2. Long hair must be tied back.

#### **Street Dance classes:**

1. All Street Dance students must wear the Theatre Peckham T-shirt (uniform) and trainers.

### Contemporary Dance classes:

1. All Contemporary Dance students must wear the Theatre Peckham t-shirt (uniform).
2. Black tracksuit bottoms or leggings (preferably long) and a pair of socks.

**Please note** ballet shoes, tap shoes, red leotards/skirts/cardigans are available to purchase at Theatre Peckham.

If the students attend classes without the correct uniform, they may be informed by the tutor that they cannot participate in their class. If members continually attend without the correct uniform this may be considered a disciplinary matter.
