



UNIFORM GUIDELINES

All Theatre Peckham Academy students are required to wear the uniform for their classes, rehearsals, open days or other performances/events. This is to ensure that they are always wearing appropriate clothing for the activities they are doing, and to ensure that they are comfortable and safe. We advise that members do not wear jewellery for safety reasons.

If the students attend classes without the correct uniform, they may not be permitted to participate. If students continually attend without the correct uniform this may be considered a disciplinary matter.

Available to purchase at Theatre Peckham: Ballet shoes, tap shoes, red leotards, red skirts, red cardigans.

For all classes: students with long hair must have it tied back.

Academy uniform code

Acting, Musical Theatre & Glee club, Singing, Producing, Acro, Steel pan, and Backstage class students should wear:

- Theatre Peckham T-shirt,
- black tracksuit bottoms or leggings/trousers you can move freely in,
- trainers

In Acro classes students might be asked to remove their shoes. We advise students to wear socks with plastic grips.

Ballet students should wear:

- red leotard, or the Theatre Peckham T-shirt,
- ballet shoes,
- black shorts/ black leggings/black or white tights,
- a red skirt/red cardigan/leg warmer (optional)

Tap students should wear:

- Theatre Peckham T-shirt,
- tap shoes,
- comfortable trousers/leggings any colour (no jeans)

Street Dance students should wear:

- Theatre Peckham T-shirt,
- trainers,
- comfortable trousers/leggings of any colour (no jeans)

Contemporary Dance students should wear:

- Theatre Peckham T-shirt,
- black tracksuit bottoms or leggings (full length)
- a pair of socks
