



## UNIFORM GUIDELINES

All Academy students are required to wear the uniform for their classes, rehearsals, open days or other performances/events. This is to ensure that they are always wearing appropriate clothing for the activities they are doing, and to ensure that they are comfortable and safe. We advise that students do not wear jewellery for safety reasons.

If the students attend classes without the correct uniform, they may not be permitted to participate.

If students continually attend without the correct uniform this may be considered a disciplinary matter.

Available to purchase at Theatre Peckham: ballet shoes, tap shoes, black unitards, red skirts, red cardigans.

For all classes: we recommend for students with long hair to have it tied back. Especially for the Ballet and Acro classes they must wear their hair tied back to ensure safety and ballet standard.

### Theatre Peckham's Academy uniform code

Acting, Musical Theatre & Glee Club, Young & Talented, Producing, Acro, Steel Pan, and Backstage class students should wear:

- Theatre Peckham Red T-shirt (Essential)
- black tracksuit bottoms or leggings/trousers you can move freely in
- trainers

In Acro classes students might be asked to remove their shoes. We advise students to wear socks with plastic grips.

**Ballet students should wear:**

- black unitard (Essential)
- ballet shoes (Essential)
- black or white tights (optional)
- a red skirt/red cardigan/leg warmers (optional)



**Tap students should wear:**

- Theatre Peckham Red T-shirt (Essential)
- tap shoes (Essential)
- comfortable trousers/leggings any colour (no jeans). Students could wear (if they wish) the black unitard.

**Street Dance students should wear:**

- Theatre Peckham Red T-shirt (Essential)
- Trainers
- comfortable trousers/leggings of any colour (no jeans)

All students should ideally arrive 10 – 15 minutes before class begins in order to ensure they allow themselves time to change and get ready for the warm-up. Without a proper warm-up, students put themselves at risk of injury.

Students who arrive 10 minutes later or more after the start of class, may not be allowed to join the class. They may be asked instead to watch the class at the tutor's discretion or to wait in the foyer until collection by a parent/guardian.
